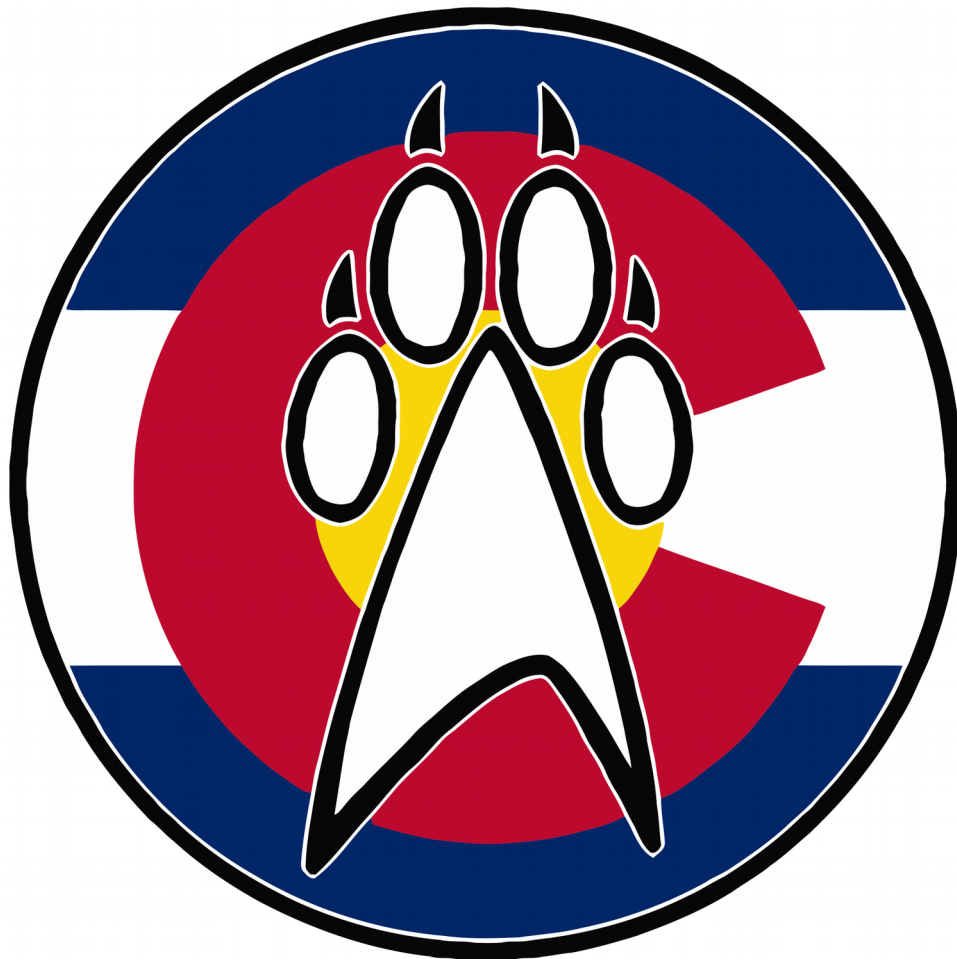

Werewords – Friday 2p – 3p

Are You A Werewolf? meets 20 Questions in this fast-playing team game. Villagers must work to guess a secret word by asking yes/no questions. The mayor provides answers, but the werewolf and seer know the word as well and must help or hinder the village without revealing their identities to each other.

Super Smash Bros Tournament – Friday 1p – 3:30p

This tournament will be melee. [Probably more info needed]

Short Deck Poker Tournament – Friday 6:00p – 8:30p

Like poker, but don't like waiting for good cards? Try this rapid-fire format and be ready for a wild ride!

Lemme Smash – Saturday 3p – 5:30p

Lemme Smash is going to be a familiar beast for those who participated in previous years "Chaos" tournaments. For those that are not familiar, however, it is a casual tournament with randomised elements such as player names being drawn from a hat to determine play order. Players are accorded 3 "lives" with 4th and 3rd place in a round losing 2, 2nd place losing 1, and the winner losing none! This year's tournament will be run using Smash Bros. Ultimate. Fans of the original Chaos Mod have nothing to fear though, as they can still play it any time.

Charity Texas Hold'em Poker – Saturday 4p - 6:30p


We will be playing 10 rounds [15 minutes each] of Texas Hold'em poker for charity. The entry fee will be \$10 per person, which will net the player 1000 in chips. 16 entrants [2 tables of 8] will be able to be enter to begin with, with other players in waiting.

In the first half hour, if a player is eliminated, one of the players in waiting may enter to maintain 16 players are at the table. If there are no players in waiting, the player eliminated can re-enter. In the second half hour, if the number of players go below 8, players may enter to maintain 8 players. Once the first hour is past, there will be no more entrants.

2 tables will be run until the number of players reaches 8, and then they will be joined into a single table, with the smaller table entering ahead of the small blind in order of their chip counts.

The antes will change every 15 minutes (a round) as per a typical tournament, as shown below. Please note, however, the surprise at round 10, the Sudden Death round:

That's right, if there are still players in the 10th round, the big blind is All-in, and little blind will be 1/2 what big blind has entered, or all-in if they have less than half. Enjoy! 

The top 4 finishers will be announced, and the prizes for this tournament are:

Artemis Bridge Simulator — Friday 8:30p — 1a & Saturday 8:30p — 12:30a

Sonic 2 Tournament — Sunday 11:30a to 1:30p

There will be a sign-up sheet posted in the game room. To sign up, write your badge name in one of the available slots. Come game time, the first 16 players who showed up on time will be selected. Those names will be randomized, and placed on a 16-player single elimination bracket, and the gameplay will begin.

Gameplay & Scoring

Each round will consist of 3 levels in one of 4 zones: Emerald Hill, Casino Night, Mystic Cave, and Special Stage. Each level will be scored by best out of the 5 following criteria: points, shortest time, total rings collected, rings held when crossing the finish line, and number of item boxes hit. Whichever player holds more of these than the other at the end of the level is the winner for that level. Whomever takes best 2 out of 3 levels wins that zone, and moves on to the next round.

Prizes

Players who progress further in the bracket will get more ribbons.
